The Residence Descartes in Tremblay, was designed by one of France's most prestigious architects, Pablo Katz. The apartments are characterized by the use of cross-laminated timber (CLT) Walls and Roofs for the balconies. The 4 storey building consists of 43 social housing residential units. In addition to the positive environmental effects the CLT create a comfortable living atmosphere for the residents. The completion of the building was in 2020. altogether the flat comprises 2 997 m².

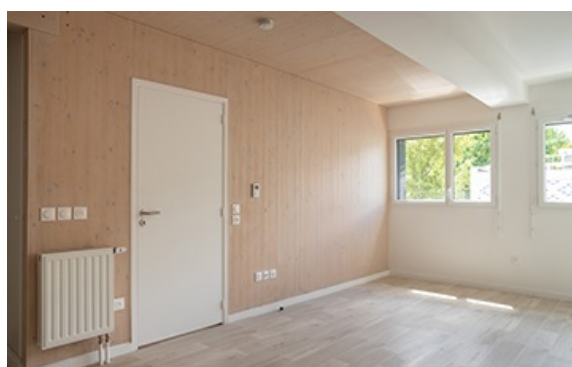

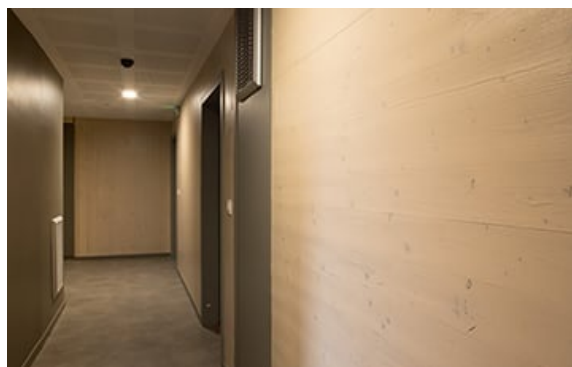
